WHEREAS, the natural beauty of wildflowers in Breward County, can be enjoyed by
everyone, attract guests and benefit commerce, environmental health, and the public's well
being; and

WHEREAS, nelyoment of wildflowers is an accasion for all County and community
leaders to unite for the benefit of everyone, and

WHEREAS, may naturally heautiful species of native wildflowers, including Coreopsis,
the State wildflower as depicted on the State wildflower heaves tag, are already prominently
displayed along many County and State roadways; and

WHEREAS, increasing the visibility of native wildflowers in Breward County is
consistent with the vision and goals of many individuals, businesses, and community based
organizations; and

WHEREAS, the presence of wildflowers is essential to native pollinator species
necessary for productive and profitable farms and forests.

NOW, THEREAS at presence of wildflowers on State and County readways, and encourages the
conservation of roadside management practices that therease the visibility and enjoynest of
Florida native wildflowers.
